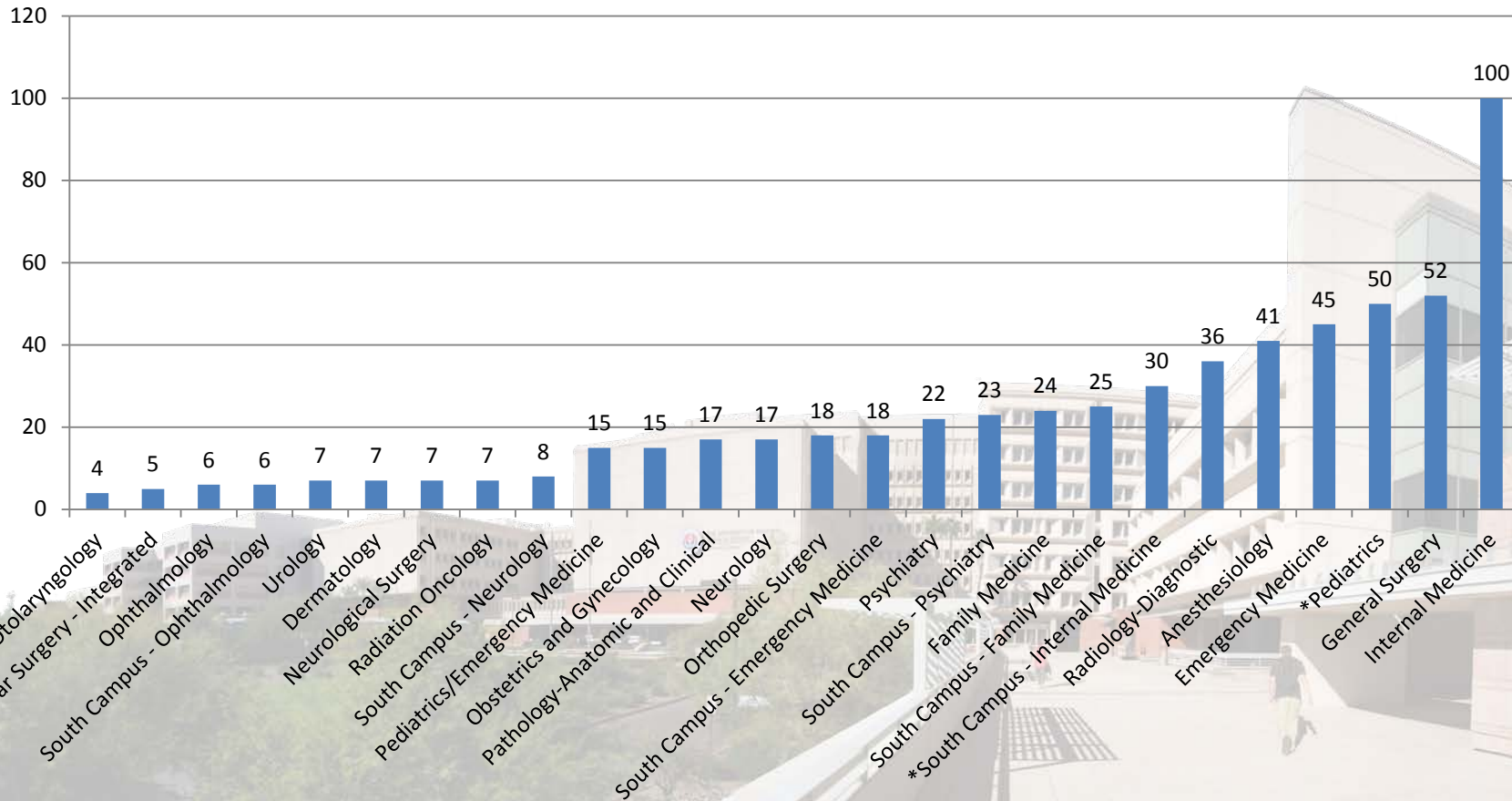

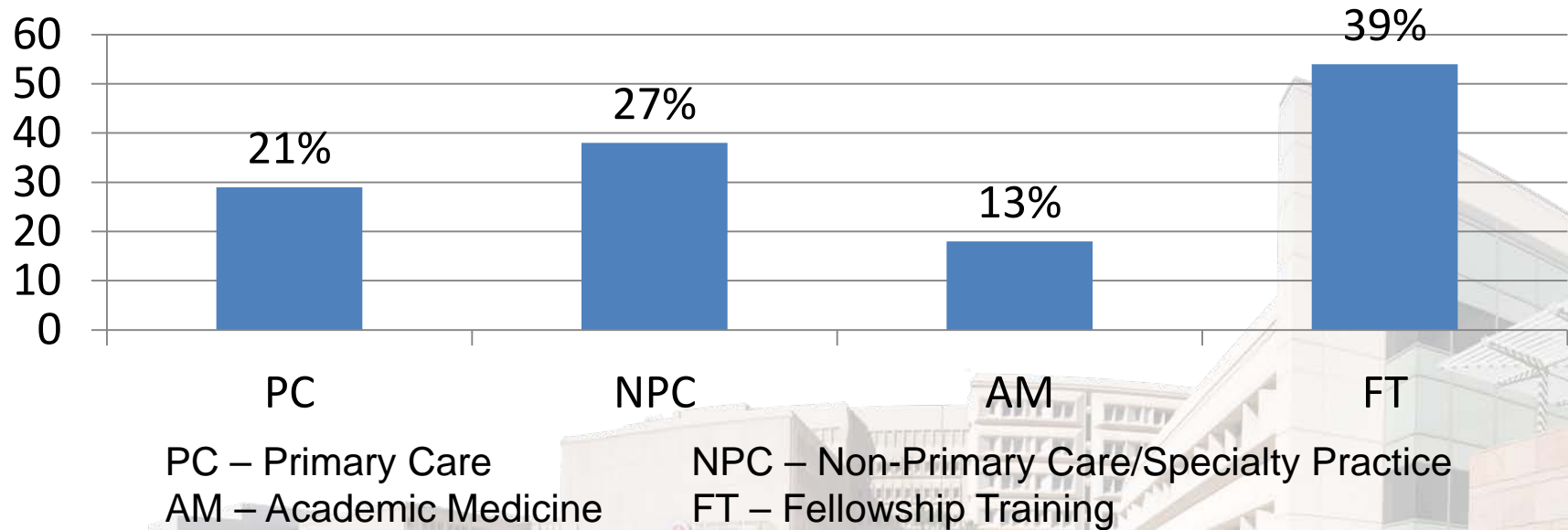

CAREERS AFTER RESIDENCY

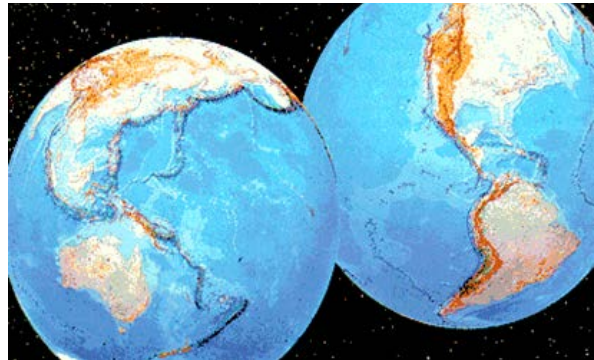


35-40% remain in Arizona after training
