

Criteria to qualify for exemption to Arizona Board of Regent Intellectual Property Policy

All listed factors must be in order to be exempt. The likelihood of inventions resulting from participation in a clinical trial must be extremely remote in order to not require consideration of IP issues under the ABOR IP Policy. The following factors must be present:

1. The Protocol was written by the Sponsor, without input from the University Investigator.
2. The drug/device is supplied by the Sponsor at no cost to the University.
3. The University Investigator follows the Sponsor's written Protocol without modification or deviation.
4. There is no intellectual or creative effort or input by the University Investigator in performing to the Protocol; it is truly a services agreement by only following the precise set of instructions from the Sponsor without deviation or variation from the Protocol.
