## **Goals of AMES include:**

- 1. Recognize excellent teachers and educators at the College of Medicine.
- 2. Support the recruitment, recognition, promotion, and retention of outstanding teachers.
- 3. Create a body of educationally oriented faculty to assist the College with:
  - a) Faculty development for teaching.
  - b) Mentoring junior faculty with an interest in education.
  - c) Peer review of faculty teaching.
- 4. Foster research in medical education.
- 5. Heighten recognition of the educational mission of the College.

#### Nominations should consist of:

- 1) A statement of interest by the candidate of no more than one page. This should include description of the candidate's achievements in two of the three specific criteria of educational scholarship, educational leadership, and educational excellence (see attached document).
- 2) The candidate's CV
- 3) A letter of support from the candidate's Department Chair or Division Chief.

Nominations will be reviewed by the AMES membership subcommittee and voted on by the full AMES membership.

Selection into AMES will be based on criteria as outlined below:

### **GENERAL CRITERIA**

- 1. Clinical or basic science faculty with MD, PhD or other terminal degrees
- 2. A record of excellence in educational leadership, educational scholarship, and/or educational excellence (2 of 3 categories) with at least 2 years at UACOM- Tucson

#### **SPECIFIC CRITERIA**

Candidates should have evidence of sustained educational excellence in a minimum of two of the following three areas:

### 1. **Educational Scholarship**

- A. Peer reviewed published papers focusing on education
- B. Peer reviewed endurable products (e.g., curriculum, learner assessment tools) accepted by medical education and/or specialty specific repositories.
- C. Education-specific grants
- D. Education-specific books
- E. Development and evaluation of instructional materials, techniques, or assessment tools
- F. National and regional peer-reviewed education presentations
- G. National and regional invited presentations on education topics

# 2. Educational Leadership

- A. UACOM Tucson Course or Clerkship Leadership
- B. Residency, graduate program, or CME director
- C. Education committee participation or other educational leadership
- D. National leadership position in educational organization

### 3. Educational Excellence

- A. Excellence in direct educational activities, as judged by measurable criteria
  - a. Course or teaching evaluations
  - b. Evidence of mentorship
  - c. Documentation of educational impact; e.g. changes in pre to post scores, changes in clinical practice, OSCE performance
  - d. Teaching awards
