The Arizona Medical Association (ARMA) Preceptor Grant

This is an easy way to apply for state funding for any uncompensated preceptorships/mentoring experiences you provide our medical students throughout the year. A number of us have gone through this process and it is relatively easy! There is a save and continue option on the application form (this is new, so you don't have to complete the application in one sitting).

Award Amount? \$1000 (per fiscal year)

What are the requirements?

- Provide an uncompensated mentoring/teaching experience for an Arizona medical student
- The experience must be at least four weeks in duration, occurring on or after January 1,
 2023
 - Note: this does not mean preceptorship must be one student for four weeks.
 When completing the form, you may provide the name and email address of a representative student and describe your preceptorship.

I already received one of these awards earlier this year. Can I apply again?

• Yes! If you have already been awarded a grant, you are eligible for a second year of funding if the preceptorship occurred on or after July 1, 2023.

What do I need before I get started with the application?

- A copy of your medical license
- Proof of professional insurance
- A completed W-9 form. *A fillable PDF form can be found here.

Where can I get a copy of my professional insurance?

Your department administrator may already have a copy on file

- If not, contact Banner HR's Risk & Insurance Analyst and ask them to assist you with the malpractice certificates.

How long does the application take to complete?

• Getting the materials together (your license and insurance certificate) is the hardest part. The rest of the application will take a maximum of 20 minutes.

Once submitted, when will I receive my funds?

 Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. It takes approximately 1–2 weeks to learn if your application is accepted. Then, keep an eye out a check in the mail approximately 2 weeks after that!
