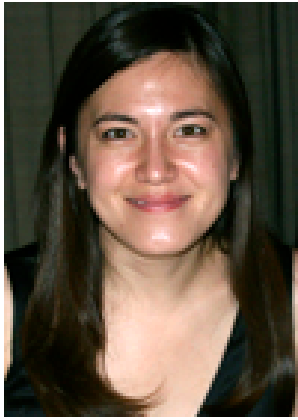

Computer Capabilities: The Thunderbird and Arrowhead sites have high-speed Internet connections, with links via the Mayo Clinic library to *Up-to-Date*, *MDCConsult*, eJournals, eBookshelf, and multiple other medical information resource sites. The practice utilizes Cerner EMR software.

Patient Population Profile: Approximately 40% are over age 65, 45% between ages 18 & 65, and 5% under age 18. Most patients are economically in the middle and upper-middle class. Males and females are equally represented.

Residency Info: All patients are seen with attending physician.

Specific Site Info: Both sites are located in residential neighborhoods. The Thunderbird location has 12 physician providers and 3 nurse-practitioners. The Arrowhead office has 5 physicians and 1 nurse-practitioner. Students will be assigned to various providers for each half-day. Most of the rotation experience will be at Thunderbird, with about one full day each week at the Arrowhead office.
